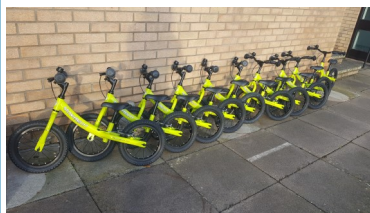
Events In School Kingswood Residential
