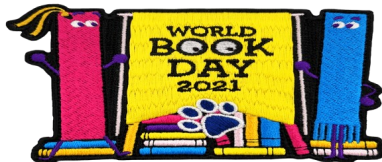

Dear Parents/Carer

Well here we are, the end of the first week back at school after the half-term holiday. The sun is shining and all children are re-joining our school on Monday 8th March. Yeah! Isn't that wonderful news.

Well done everyone for all that you have done during this period of Lockdown, making it work for you and your family. But the end is truly in sight now.

I would like to reassure you that we will continue to operate the school day similar to how we were working in December, including school drop-off and collection.

Please DO NOT come to school before 8.45am in the morning and 3.15pm in the afternoon. If parents arrive early then parents have to queue. If parents queue, it delays the children coming in or leaving the school.

Please wear a face covering when dropping off and/or collecting your child. There are close to 150-200 adults, as well as the school children moving to and from school at the start and end of school day. Protect each other.

Please DO NOT congregate before/after school, outside the school, at the park or other areas of the village. Reduce the risk of transmission and protect the class 'bubbles.' Please follow the one-way system in place through Church Street and onto either the school's pedestrian path and/or the Church footpath and through the school's car park.

Please DO NOT allow your children to socialise with other children from different classes' bubbles.' Please help to protect the class 'bubbles' and keep our school open.

Please also visit the [COVID 19](#) section of the school's website to read the updated Risk Assessments before returning to school. Thank you.

We are busily preparing for the return of all our children. It is fair to say that we are excited by this but also need to be realistic. The Lockdown period is going to have been different for each of us and once the children return we will need to begin to put systems in place to 'catch up' their learning. To that end, I thought I'd share with you our intentions.

Once children return to school, we plan to settle them back into school life in the first week back, after which we will assess the children's standards in a range of subjects within the following 2 weeks of being back in school. Once done, teachers will analyse the impact of the most recent lockdown and identify individual strengths and barriers, as well as identify ways to overcome those barriers. We then plan to hold Parent/Teacher Consultations to inform parents of next steps for each child, after the Easter holidays, on Tuesday 27th and Wednesday 28th April 2021.

Try not to worry. It is inevitable that this lockdown period will be different for all of us and this will be reflected in the children. We will plan a considered and effective way to support all our children to 'catch up' any 'lost learning' during this time. Well done to everyone and thank you for trying your best-that is all we can ever do. I hope you enjoy reading this week's newsletter and have a lovely weekend.
