Frozen Fridays

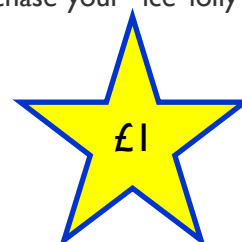


Frozen Fridays are back! Our wonderful FOBs members will be selling Ice Lollies, every Friday from **Friday 10th June**.
