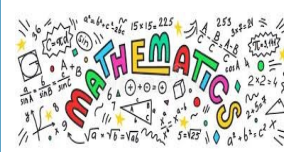
Secondary School Transition

The children were absolutely amazing! Playing with sportsmanship, enjoyment and showing off magnificent cricket skills. Go team Barrowby.

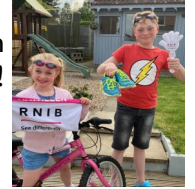
Thanksgiving Service - Mrs Wright

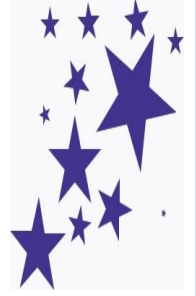

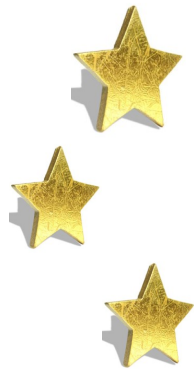

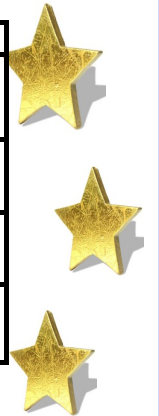
