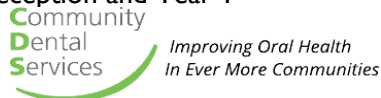

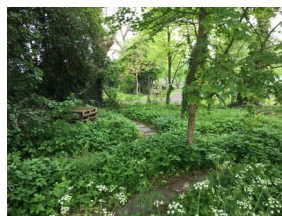
Year 6 BBQ
