Bikeability

This week, our Year 5 children have been enjoying taking part in their Bikeability cycling proficiency training. They have really enjoyed it! To begin with, the children practised on the playground and made sure that they were safe while riding their bikes as well as having their bikes checked to see if they were 'road worthy, as part of their Level 1 training.'

When the children were confident enough on the playground, they were then taken out in to the village, riding on roads to complete Level 2 of their training!



The children listened carefully to the instructors who guided them on how to safely ride a bike on the road including how to balance while indicating and how to turn in and out of a junction. The children absolutely loved it and have now been given advice from their instructors indicating whether they completed all aspects of the training independently or whether they require more practice.

Certificates and badges were awarded in today's Collective Worship. Perhaps some of our Year 5 children may well cycle to school over the coming weeks. 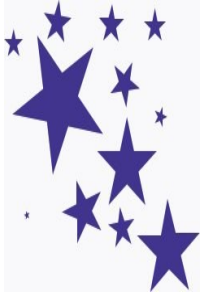

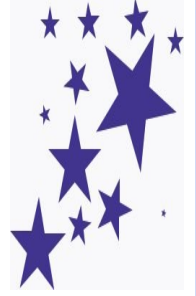

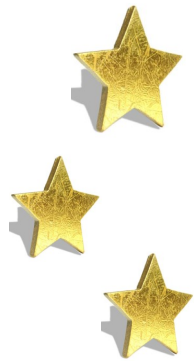
