LIVES First Aid - Year 6

On Thursday 17th March, our Year 6 children took part in a workshop run by Lincolnshire integrated voluntary emergency service (LIVES). The children learnt about DR ABC, which stands for danger, response, airway, breathing and then circulation. They had chance to have a go at CPR on a dummy model and the volunteers from LIVES made sure all the children completed CPR correctly. The children came away from the session with a secure knowledge of emergency first aid.

School closes for the Easter holidays on Thursday 31st March 2022 and we return to school on Wednesday 20th April 2022.

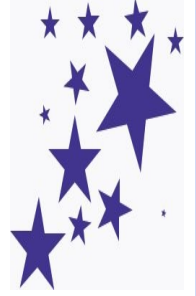
