

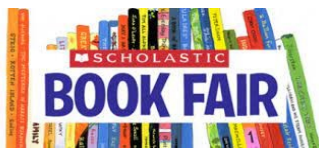

Year 6 Maths Revision

The parents guide includes the dates of the SATS, some information about which SATs your child will be taking and some ideas of how to help your child at home. The Maths revision guide is a tool to help our Year 6's revise tricky mathematical concepts that have been taught in school, and assist parents with how the concept has been taught.

Alongside TT rockstars, our Year 6 children will be expected to use the Maths revision guide to help them choose which strands of maths to revise, and complete this as directed. We hope that our Year 6 parents will support their child/ren with this. In addition, before the Easter holidays Year 6 will receive a pack of maths, reading and grammar revision work to be completed over the Easter holidays in readiness for their SATs in May. 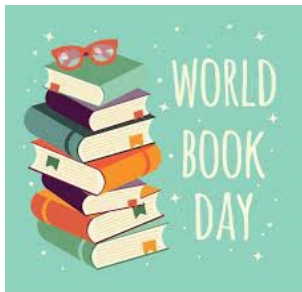

World Book Day



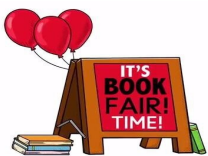
Today, Friday 4th March the children and staff took part in World Book Day, The theme for this year was 'Character from a book that you would recommend that inspires you or makes you smile.'

Wednesday 9th March: Reception, Year 2 and 5

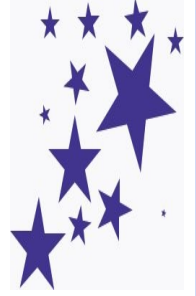
