Roots to Food

This week, on Thursday 17th September, our Year 4 and Year 5 pupils were lucky enough to have a visit from Chef Darren and to do some cooking as part of Roots to Food! The children enjoyed smelling the different herbs and spices they would be cooking with, and spoke about different ingredients they would use.



They had to marinade the turkey mince and let it 'rest' in the pan, while they practised the 'claw' method to slice up the vegetables. The children used their whisking skills to develop the smoky paprika and tomato sauce and finally – once cooked, got to taste their finished dish! It was absolutely delicious and they all had an amazing time!
