On **Monday 17th July from 5.00pm-7.00pm**, our Year 6 children are invited to their Leaver's Party.

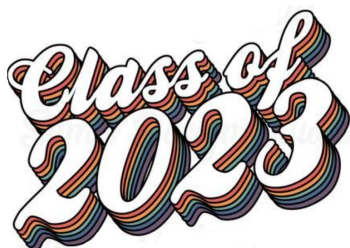
The theme for this year is '**Beach Party**' and the children are welcome to dress up for this theme if they would like to.
