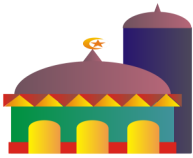

### Key Stage 1 SATS

Throughout May, our Y2 children have been sitting their SATs. The Year 2 SATs are statutory in the UK nationwide, and serve as a marker to evaluate how well children are learning and retaining the information taught in KSI. The children have completed two Maths SATs, Paper 1- Arithmetic and Paper 2- Reasoning.



They have also completed Paper 1 in Reading and will sit Paper 2 next week. The teachers in Y2 have been very impressed with the children's resilience and enthusiasm for the SATs. They have worked very hard and demonstrated maturity and independence in both thought and action. Well done Y2, your teachers are so proud of you.

[Navigating Teenage Relationships workshop by Lincolnshire Domestic Abuse Partnership 17<sup>th</sup> May 2023 6-7pm FREE TEAMS event sign up required:](#)

When your young person begins to date and become romantically involved with peers, their life can seem exciting, but can also be extremely difficult. Teenagers don't always like to talk about what is happening in their love life however 'Navigating teenage relationships' aims to provide parents and guardians with a toolkit, to support your young person through the complexities of having a healthy relationship. The Lincolnshire Domestic Abuse Partnership (LDAP) will run a one hour online TEAMS workshop on the 17<sup>th</sup> May 6-7pm. During the evening LDAP will discuss what young people talk about in Lincolnshire regarding relationships and red flags to look out for in relationships. They will also talk about where help and support can be found and how you can best support as a parent. The team is also happy to answer any questions you may have through the night.

Over two thirds of students surveyed in the LSCP 2022 Keeping Safe Online Survey indicated that they access their devices once they have gone to bed, and that many parents and carers don't know anything about what they do online. The survey also showed when parents talked openly to their children about their activity online, those students were less likely to experience cyberbullying and more likely to access support.

## Reminders



### Year 5 visit St Philip's Centre

On Thursday 25th May, our Year 5 children will be visiting the St Philip's Centre as part of their RE studies in Leicester. While at the centre they will participate in faith based 'compare and contrast' interactive learning and activities. They will then reflect on the differences between Barrowby and Leicester in terms of faith diversity and have the opportunity to ask any questions they may have.

The children will also visit a mosque. Whilst there they will have the opportunity to speak to a Muslim faith practitioner. They will learn about the history and development of Islam as well as Muslim ways of worship and living. They will also gain a deeper understanding of the purpose and features of a mosque.

Children will need to be in their full school uniform e.g. trousers for boys no shorts and mid-grey skirts with long white socks for girls no summer dresses; girls should also take a scarf to cover their head. All children will also need to be provided with a packed lunch and their water bottles.
