Year 6 Visit to Lincoln Cathedral - Church Schools' Festival

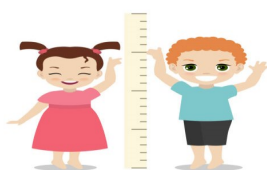
