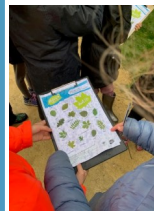
Dear Parents/Carers,

On Friday 21st April, our Year 4 children travelled to Lonthorpe woods to support their learning last term about our local area.

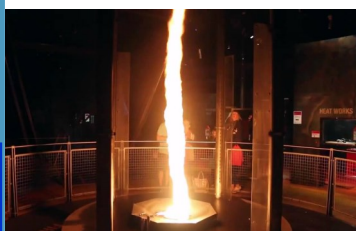

We were absolutely delighted with the children's achievements last night. They showed a real 'can do' attitudes.

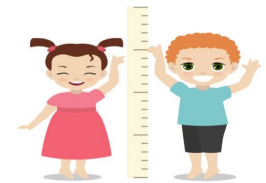
