Farm Kitchen

Have you registered with our hot school meal provider - The Farm Kitchen? You will have received an 'Introduction to The Farm Kitchen' letter via Parentmail, informing you of our new hot school meal provider - The Farm Kitchen, this will commence from week beginning 18th April. We have been advised by **The Farm Kitchen** that the menu's for after Easter should be available for parents the week beginning **20th March 2023**.



In readiness for this you may wish to register with The Farm Kitchen so you are ready to place orders once the menus are available.

For those children in:

- **Reception, Year 1 and Year 2:** as your child/ren are in receipt of the Universal Infant Free School Meal you have been automatically enrolled by The Farm Kitchen. **You will receive a further letter from them providing instructions on how to access your account, tonight.** Please check your child's book bag.
- **Years 3, 4, 5 and 6:** (and are not in receipt of Pupil Premium) you will need to click the link below or visit our school's website: [School Life - Meals In School](#) in order to register and create an account with the new school meal provider: The Farm Kitchen before placing an order.
- **Years 3, 4, 5 and 6:** (and are in receipt of Pupil Premium) you have been automatically enrolled by The Farm Kitchen. **You will receive a further letter from them providing instructions on how to access your account, tonight.** Please check your child's bag.

We are hopeful that our new school meal provider will continue to support our school's aim of being a healthy school and offers a comprehensive menu for parents and children alike. You will continue to order and pay (unless UIFSM or Pupil Premium) via an online portal for The Farm Kitchen and the meals will be delivered into school.

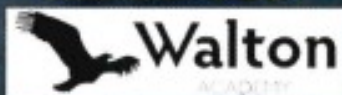

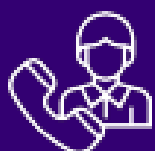

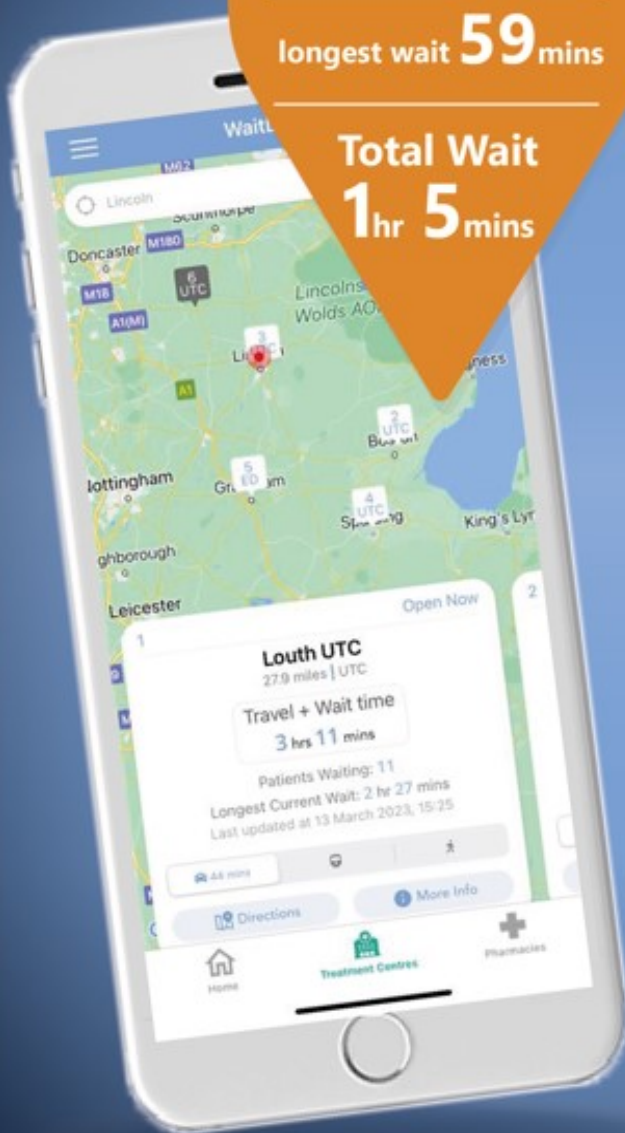
