House Paralympic Tournament



The whole school had a wonderful time participating in this year's Paralympic Values House Competition. The competition encouraged teamwork and showcased the values of Courage, Determination, Inspiration and Equality.

The children took part in two exciting games: Blind Fold Trail and Bench Balance Ball. In the Blind Fold Trail, children led their blindfolded team through an obstacle course while demonstrating courage and determination. In the Bench Balance Ball game, they showed their inspiration and equality as they worked together with a partner to balance a ball and walk across a bench without dropping it. Each teams had 5 minutes to earn as many points as possible.

The children demonstrated all of the Paralympic values and had a great time competing in their teams. The final results are: 3rd Place: Armstrong (220 points), 2nd Place: Chichester (310 points) and 1st Place: Scott (350 points).

Well done everyone for taking part and a special thank you to our young leaders - the Sports Committee. They organised such a fun, whole school event! You showed great leadership and compassion working with children from Reception to Year 6.

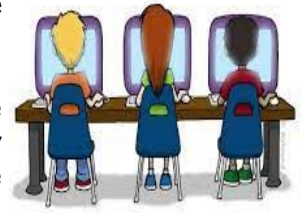

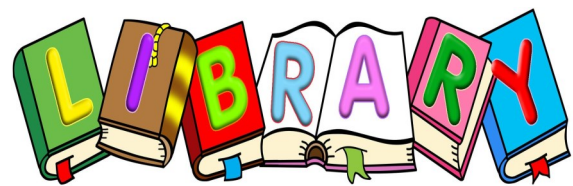
Library Open Evenings
