Key Stage 2 Spelling: Supporting Spelling at Home

- Weekly homework task across Key Stage 2.
- Builds on from what the children have learnt that week.
- Remember: the 'Spelling Jotter' includes an explanation as to how it should be used.
- Gives ideas for games and activities you may select from to do with your children and includes the appropriate curriculum words.
- Children will be set 'Spelling Homework' each week.
- Space for children to write down words they wish or need to focus on.
- Space for making notes of rules or helpful tips.
- Spelling Homework task to be completed in the 'Spelling Jotter.'
- Please ensure children are completing this to a high standard and that you, as parents **are signing their books.**
- Use the appropriate word list as a starter to help you generate words – this will give a good idea of how to make it age appropriate.
- Don't just focus on the word lists – it's all about using the spelling patterns and words.
- If searching for further words avoid mono-syllabic words and overly complex words. Can my child understand this word?
