

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The Seven Areas of Learning and Development

Personal, Social and Emotional Development — Your child will learn to be self-confident, take an interest in things, know what their own needs are, tell the difference between right and wrong, and be able to dress and undress.

Communication and Language — Your child will learn to talk confidently and clearly, enjoying stories, songs, rhymes and poems.

Physical Development — Your child will learn to move confidently, controlling their body. They will climb and balance, jump and roll. They will develop small physical skills and learn to handle equipment. They will also begin to develop an awareness of their own physical and health needs.

Literacy — They will learn new words, develop listening skills and hear and say sounds. They will look at books and print and begin to make marks and patterns.

Mathematics — Your child will develop an understanding of maths through stories, songs, games and imaginative play. They will become comfortable with numbers and with ideas such as 'heavier than' or 'bigger'. They will become aware of shapes and space.

Understanding the World — Your child will explore and find out the world around them, asking questions about it. They will build with different materials, know about everyday technology and learn what it is used for. They will find out about past events in their lives and will begin to show an awareness of other cultures and beliefs.

Expressive Arts and Design — Your child will explore colours and shapes in their play. They will try out dancing and moving and make things using their imagination. They will tell stories using props and puppets, learn new songs and make music.

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
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
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
